# Halifax Swimming Club

# Fees for 2023

Every swimmer must be a member of the club.

Those swimmers, who belong to more than one club, must decide which club to use for initial registration with Swim England . Swim Compete fees will be payable through that club. A dual membership form must be filled in and signed by the relevant official from both clubs.

### Membership due on 1<sup>st</sup> January and must be paid by 31<sup>st</sup> January 2023

Children: £60.00 for the first child and £55.00 for siblings

From 1<sup>st</sup> July £40.00 for the first child and £5 for siblings

From 1<sup>st</sup> October £30.00 for the first child and £25 for siblings

Under our new constitution, the club must collect a membership fee for one adult in every family. Most of this money is payable directly to Swim England, Swim North East and Yorkshire Swimming Association

Adults: £15.00. If two adults from the same family wish to be members then the second person will pay £7.00

### Swim England Registration

As we are a competitive club, the ASA Registration fee is necessary for every club member and helper. This enables the swimmers to take part in Open Meets, County Championships etc. This is an annual payment fixed by the ASA and includes insurance.

Club support	Shall include all members of any age who are not in Categories One or Two including, but not being limited to, any persons who have voting rights in their club by virtue of being a parent of or a person with parental responsibility for a member in Categories One or Two; administrators, associate members; coaches; helpers; honorary members; life members; officers; qualified officials of any discipline; patrons; teachers; temporary members;	£5.00 Paid by club

For existing members, the Swim Compete registration fee must be paid with the membership fee in January each year. If not paid, the swimmer will be unable to swim in any gala held under ASA law. All Yorkshire and Regional Development groups need to pay Swim Compete registration.

The Club is also responsible for paying fees to the Swim England North Eastern Region along with the Yorkshire Swimming Association. Next year this will be £5.60 per registered member. We do not make an extra charge to you for this.

#### Training Fees

Swimming fees are due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month for 48 weeks of training. These are collected by standing order or direct transfer. If this is a problem please talk to Christine at the welcome table.

Your payment covers club membership, Category 1 and Category 3 membership fees for The Amateur Swimming Association, insurance, pool hire fees, payments for some hours worked for the Head and Assistant Coaches and continuous training for the coaching and teaching staff. All other teachers and coaches are volunteers.
